Runners are the most junior positions on a film. Managed by the office, runners transport stuff between the production office and set, and also pick up anything else needed for the crew. Get friendly with the runners and they'll be able to help you out in so many ways.

Terminology used



- Call – the time that you must be on set, ready to work
- Unit base – where all departments are based from, not necessarily next to where the film is being shot

Terminology used



- On camera – the time everybody is expected to be ready for the first take
- Rolling / turning / (at) speed – the camera (& sound) are now recording
- Cut – the camera (& sound) are stopping recording
- End boards – the panicked call of the camera trainee / clapper loader who forget to do this before the take, means that camera & sound will be recording for another 30 seconds

Terminology used



- Hold (stop) the work – from an annoyed AD as somebody made a noise when the cameras were rolling
- Lock off – a set (& cameras) that needs to left untouched
- Wrap – the end of filming for the day
- Derig – the time following wrap when everyone packs away
- Tail lights / hard out – the time at which everybody must be off site

Radiocommunications



- May be a dedicated channel for medics (shared with H&S)
- Otherwise, the rules-of-thumb are:
 - Unit medics follow ADs
 - Construction medics follow Locations
- Radios are 'silent mode' by default
- No formal protocols
